**Admissions 2023** – Parents who applied to admit their child into Nursery or Primary 1 in September 2023 will receive notification of their applications on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April. Notification will be through the EA website and we will also issue letters from the school.

**Budget Cuts** - You will have seen on the news over the past week, the decision taken to end a number of programmes. 'Engage' employed a teacher in the school on a full-time basis to help children to catch up in their learning after lockdown periods. The Board of Governors has decided to fund the teaching post until the end of June as this vital resource is still needed. 'Happy Healthy Minds' employed a Play Therapist one afternoon a week to work with children who are finding themselves in difficult situations in their lives. This programme has brought much needed assistance to many children. We will endeavor to keep this programme going until the end of June despite drastic cuts.

Children receiving free school meals will see payments cease during holiday periods beginning immediately. The overall education budget has seen an overall cut. With prices continuing to rise, it will inevitably mean that there will be further strain on services in the school. This is not what the staff or Board of Governors want as it affects every child in the school. We will endeavor to maintain quality learning and teaching experiences for all children and aim to give them what we can to enhance their primary school experience.
