**School Development Day -** School will be closed for pupils on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> November.

**Confirmation** - Bishop Duffy will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> March at 6pm in Holy Cross Church. Children will wear school uniform and a special collar supplied by the parish.

**Parent - Teacher Meetings -** will be conducted by phone call this year over a two-week period starting 16<sup>th</sup> November. As there are large numbers in each class, each call will last no more than 10 mins. Further details on what day each class teacher will hold their meetings will be communicated by teachers through learning platforms SeeSaw or Google Classroom.

**Regulations** - The Department of Education has advised that parents do not gather in large groups in or around the school grounds. Whilst in the school grounds a mask must be worn and adults must maintain a 2m distance from others.

We will have the Make your Own Choices Day on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> November. There will be no uniform that day and children may wear their own clothes. Please be advised of suitable footwear while children are out playing and suitable clothing for the time of year. Forms can still be returned with money if not already done so.

**Gaelic Coach** - Mr Keith Reilly has started Gaelic skills coaching again on Mondays. With the onset of winter, the weather may not play its part in facilitating coaching outdoors. Children should come to school with a coat and suitable footwear.
