you to buy anything. It would help us if you could look for these items at home or ask relatives and

work colleagues and friends.

In the interests of safety, we cannot accept any items which are damaged, broken or with sharp edges.

We are very grateful of any items which you can donate.

These items will be used by children daily as they investigate and explore through play. We thank you
